- Age must be minimum 17 years at the time of admission

 University or equivalent Examination conducted by statutory Universities or
 Boards with Science subject namely Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Botany
 & zoology and secured 50% of marks in the aggregate are eligible for
 admission to I BAMScourse, provided the candidate has passed the PUC
 Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English as one of the
 languages.
