Complete Eligibility Criteria for MBBS Admission for Indian Students

- Completed 17 years of age, and Completed 10+2 years of education or Intermediate of Science or equivalent, with English, Biology, Physics and Chemistry as main subjects
- Passed in all the subjects mentioned above, securing not less than 50% of marks in the subjects mentioned above put together and obtaining an aggregate of 50% overall
- Candidate should be qualified under NEET-UG
- Must have studied in an English medium school, or have at least studied English as a subject
- Valid Indian passport
- Valid NMC certificate

Documentations Required to Process Admission:

All students proceeding to take admission for MBBS in Nepal must have the below list of documents at the time of admission:

- Birth certificate, 10+2 certificate and mark
- Conduct certificate signed by the Head of the Institute student last studied at
- Nationality ID (Aadhar Card/ Passport)
- 8 Passport size Photographs
- NEET Scorecard
- Eligibility certificate and other certificates
- Migration certificates. Invitation letter
