Admission

A Student Council will set its own objectives. Some general objectives could include

- To enhance communication between students, management and staff.
- To promote an environment conducive to educational and personal development
- To promote friendship and respect among pupils
- To support the management and staff in the development of the college
- To represent the views of the students on matters of general concern to them.

A Student Council will identify activities that it would like to be involved in organising, although the final decision on the activities of a Student Council should be agreed with college management. A Student Council should not through its activities interfere with or detract from, the authority of college management or the teaching staff of the college. It is therefore not a function of a Student Council to discuss or comment on matters relating to the employment or professional affairs of the Principal, teachers and other staff of the college, or to become involved in any issues that fall within their professional competence.

The college shall establish and maintain procedures for the purpose of informing about the activities in the college.

The college shall encourage and help students to set up a Student Council and shall assist a Student Council when established.

The college shall draw up rules for the establishment of a Student Council which shall provide for the selection of members and the dissolution of a Council.

The college will have a role in considering the rules governing meetings of the Student Council, and the conduct of its affairs.

Management will give active support to the student council. This could involve designating a student advisor in the college to communicate with the Council on an ongoing basis, as well as assisting the Council in drawing up a constitution and in planning and organising its activities.
