About



Hind Institute of Medical Sciences (HIMS), Lucknow was established in the year 2009 and it is recognised by the Medical Council of India (MCI), Indian Nursing Council and Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. HIMS Lucknow offers a total of 35 courses at the diploma, undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The institute is affiliated to Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad. HIMS Lucknow has a total student enrollment of 1586 and a faculty size of 305 members. The institution offers admission in the streams of medicine & allied sciences, pharmacy and sciences. HIMS Lucknow provides a variety of facilities and infrastructure to its students.

The mission of the institute is to provide the best teaching of medical, paramedical courses with modern infrastructure and facilities. The vision of the institute is to provide free medical care to the weaker sections of society.

Admission

The admissions of HIMS are offered at the diploma, undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The streams in which these admissions are offered are medicine & allied sciences, pharmacy and sciences. HIMS Lucknow admissions to MBBS courses are offered on the basis of marks obtained in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET). HIMS Lucknow admissions to MD/MS courses are offered on the basis of marks obtained in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Postgraduate) (NEET-PG) examination. The final admissions are only offered to students who have taken part in the counselling process, verified their documents and paid the admission fees. HIMS Lucknow admission procedure to various courses along with their eligibility criteria and seats are given below:

HIMS Lucknow offers a variety of undergraduate courses. The minimum eligibility criteria for admissions to these courses is that the candidate must have passed 10+2 or its equivalent from a recognised board. The duration of undergraduate courses varies from 2 to 4.5 years. The eligibility criteria and the seats for undergraduate courses are as follows:

Courses Seats Eligibility Criteria

GNM	100	10+2 or its equivalent from any recognised board with relevant subjects.
<u>ANM</u>	40	
<u>MBBS</u>	100	10+2 or its equivalent from any recognised board with Science stream and must have qualified National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET).
<u>BSc. Nursing</u>	50	10+2 or its equivalent from any recognised board with Science stream.

- Candidates have to apply and appear for NEET UG conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA).
- The candidates have to meet the NEET UG cut off and register themselves for the counselling process.
- Candidates must choose HIMS Lucknow as their choice during the seat allotment process. It must be noted that NEET counselling has two types: One is All India counselling conducted by DGHS for 15% All India Quota seats and the second one is the state counselling held by each individual state medical council for the rest of the 85% of the seats.

- Based on these choices filled and seats available in the college, NEET UG All India Rank, reservation criteria and various factors, candidates are granted admission.
- The final selection of candidates is offered after payment of the admission fees and document verification.

HIMS Lucknow offers a variety of postgraduate courses. The minimum eligibility criteria for admissions to these courses is that the candidates must have passed graduation in relevant fields. The duration of postgraduate courses varies from 2 to 3 years. The eligibility criteria and the seats for undergraduate courses are as follows:

Courses	Seats	Eligibility Criteria
Post Basic BSc. Nursing	40	Passed General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) to be eligible to pursue this course.
M.D.	39	An MBBS degree or its equivalent qualifications as specified by the Medical Council of India (MCI)
M.S.	12	
M. Sc.	16	Passed B. Sc. Nursing and have one year of clinical experience.

- Candidates have to apply and appear for NEET PG conducted by the National Board of Examinations.
- The candidates have to meet the NEET PG cut off and register themselves for the counselling process.
- Candidates must choose HIMS Lucknow as their choice during the seat allotment process. It must be noted that NEET PG counselling has two types: One is All India counselling conducted by DGHS for 15% All India Quota seats and the second one is the state counselling held by each individual state medical council for the rest of the 85% of the seats.
- Based on these choices filled and seats available in the college, NEET PG All India Rank, reservation criteria and various factors, candidates are granted admission.

- The final selection of candidates is offered after payment of the admission fees and document verification.
