Admission Criteria in Gautam Institute of Pharmacy includes some admission process and eligibility criteria in the available courses which are discussed below.

2 Diploma In Pharmacy (D.Pharma)	2 Years

Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) course - pass in any of the following examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

1. Intermediate examination in Science;
2. The first year of the three year degree course in Science,
3. 10+2 examination (academic stream) in Science;
4. Pre-degree examination;
5. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examination.

Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination

by the Association of Indian Universities with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology as optional subjects individually.
